2 suitable volunteers to staff an emergency security force at
3 the school. If the sheriff determines the number of suitable
4 volunteers is sufficient, he or she may initiate an emergency
5 security force program for the school.

6 (c) Upon formation of an emergency security force,
7 the sheriff, in conjunction with administrative school
8 personnel, shall prepare a detailed crisis plan for the school
9 that includes a comprehensive plan of action for the emergency
10 security force to follow in the event the security of the
11 school is compromised or the safety of students or employees
12 is threatened. The plan shall also specify how and where
13 weapons may be stored and carried by emergency security force
14 members and circumstances under which certain weapons may be
15 used. All weapons and equipment used shall be approved by the
16 sheriff.

17 (d) A volunteer emergency security force member
18 shall be classified as a reserve deputy sheriff and shall
19 serve in that position at the pleasure of the sheriff. Service
20 as a reserve deputy sheriff under this section shall not
21 include the power of arrest. As a member of an emergency
22 security force, a volunteer shall receive any training deemed
23 necessary by the sheriff and, when fulfilling his or her
24 duties as a member of the emergency security force, shall be
25 under the supervision and direction of the sheriff. The
26 sheriff may offer self defense or other training to those

1 school employees who are not selected to serve on an emergency
2 security force.

3 (e) An emergency security force member shall receive
4 no compensation for his or her service on an emergency
5 security force, but may be reimbursed for actual necessary
6 expenses incurred in the discharge of his or her duties on
7 behalf of the emergency security force from funds otherwise
8 appropriated by the local board of education. Nothing in this
9 subsection shall prohibit a local board of education from
10 providing a salary supplement to the members of an emergency
11 security force.

12 (f) Expenses related to the training of emergency
13 security force members and the purchase of any equipment and
14 weapons deemed necessary by the sheriff shall be administered
15 by the local board of education and paid from funds
16 appropriated for that purpose.

17 (g) Each local board of education in the county
18 shall oversee and provide for the implementation of this
19 section within the schools under its jurisdiction.

20 Section 2. The provisions of this act are severable.
21 If any part of this act is declared invalid or
22 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part
23 which remains.

24 Section 3. This act shall become effective
25 immediately following its passage and approval by the
26 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
