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23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-73-127 is repealed.	
24	4 5-73-127. Possession of loaded center-fire weapons in certain	areas.
25	5 (a) It is unlawful to possess a loaded center-fire weapon, c	ther than
26	6 a shotgun and other than in a residence or business of the owner, i	n the
27	7 following areas:	
28	8 (1) Baxter County:	
29	9 (Λ) That part bounded on the south by Highway 17	8, on the
30	0 west and north by Bull Shoals Lake, and on the east by the Central	Electric
31	Power Corporation transmission line from Howard Greek to Highway 17	8;
32	2 (B) That part of Bidwell Point lying south of th	e east-
33	3 west road which crosses Highway 101 at the Presbyterian Church;	
34	4 (C) That part of Bidwell Point lying west of Ben	nett's
35	5 Bayou and north of the east-west road which crosses Highway 101 at	the
36	6 Presbyterian Church;	

1	(D) That part of Baxter County between:
2	(i) County Road 139 and Lake Norfork to the north
3	and west;
4	(ii) County Road 151 and Lake Norfork to the north,
5	west, and south in the Diamond Bay area;
6	(iii) The Bluff Road and Lake Norfork to the west;
7	(iv) John Lewis Road (Timber Lake Manor) and Lake
8	Norfork to the west and south;
9	(v) The south end of County Road 91 south of its
10	intersection with John Lewis Road and Lake Norfork to the south and east; and
11	(vi) County Road 150 from its intersection with
12	County Road 93 south and Lake Norfork to the south and east but not east of
13	County Road 93;
14	(2) Benton County:
15	(A) That part of the Hobbs Estate north of State Highway
16	12, west of Rambo Road, and south and east of Van Hollow Creek and the Van
17	Hollow Creek arm of Beaver Lake;
18	(B) All of Bella Vista Village; and
19	(C) That part bounded on the north by Beaver Lake, on the
20	east by Beaver Lake, on the south by the Hobbs State Management Area boundary
21	from the intersection of State Highway 12 eastward along the boundary to its
22	intersection with the Van Hollow Creek arm of Beaver Lake;
23	(3) Benton and Carroll Counties: That part bounded on the north
24	by Highway 62, on the east by Highway 187 and Henry Hollow Creek, and the
25	south and west by Beaver Lake and the road from Beaver Dam north to Highway

28	Jean Mountain;
29	(5) Garland County: All of Hot Springs Village and Diamondhead;

31	(A) That part known as Bull Shoals Peninsula, bounded on
32	the east and north by White River and Lake Bull Shoals, on the west by the
33	Jimmie Creek arm of Lake Bull Shoals, and on the south by the municipal
34	boundaries of the City of Bull Shoals;
35	(B) That part of Marion County bounded on the north, west,
36	and south by Bull Shoals Lake and on the east by County Roads 355 and 322

1 from their intersections with State Highway 202 to the points where they 2 respectively dead-end at arms of Bull Shoals Lake; (C) The Yocum Bend Peninsula of Bull Shoals Lake bounded 3 4 on the north and east by Bull Shoals Lake, on the west by Pine Mountain and 5 Bull Shoals Lake, and on the south by County Road 30; and 6 (D) Those lands situated in Marion County known as the 7 Frost Point Peninsula, not inundated by the waters of Bull Shoals Lake, being 8 more particularly described as follows: 9 (i) Section Six, Township Twenty North, Range Fifteen West, (Sec. 6 - T.20 N. - R.15 W.), lying south of the White River 10 11 channel: 12 (ii) Section One, Township Twenty North, Range 13 Sixteen West, (Sec. 1 - T.20 N. - R.16 W.); and 14 (iii) East Half of Section Two, Township Twenty 15 North, Range Sixteen West, (E & Sec. 2 - T.20 N. - R.16 W.); North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Eleven, Township Twenty North, Range Sixteen 16 17 West (N ½ - NE ½ Sec. 11 - T.20 N. - R.16 W.); and 18 (7) A platted subdivision located in an unincorporated area. 19 (b) Nothing contained in this section shall be construed to limit or 20 restrict or to make unlawful the discharge of a firearm in defense of a 21 person or property within the areas described in this section. 22 (c) A person who is found guilty or who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to violating this section is guilty of a violation and shall be 23 fined no less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than five hundred 24 dollars (\$500). 25 26 (d) This section does not apply to a: 27 (1) Law enforcement officer in the performance of his or her 28 duties; 29 (2) Discharge of a center-fire weapon at a firing range 30 maintained for the discharging of a center-fire weapon; or 31 (3) Person possessing a valid concealed handgun license under § 32 5-73-301 et seg. 33 34 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-73-130(c), concerning definitions used in regard to seizure and forfeiture of a firearm, is amended to read as follows: 35 36 (c) As used in this section, "unlawfully in possession of a firearm"

1	does not include any act of possession of a firearm that is prohibited only
2	by ÷
3	(1) Section 5-73-127, unlawful to possess loaded center-fire
4	weapons in certain areas; or
5	(2) A <u>a</u> regulation or rule of the Arkansas State Game and Fish
