Subtitle of House Bill No. 1327

CONCERNING A CURRENT OR FORMER JUDGE'S ABILITY TO LAWFULLY CARRY A HANDGUN
WHERE CARRYING A HANDGUN WOULD OTHERWISE BE PROHIBITED.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1327

Amend House Bill No. 1327 as engrossed H2/24/21 (version: 02/24/2021 10:49:25 AM):

Page 1, delete line 31, and substitute the following:
"handgun under § 5-73-301 et seq.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 12-15-202(d), concerning a person's eligibility to carry a concealed handgun, is amended to read as follows:

(d) ~~Any A~~ certified law enforcement officer, or retired law enforcement officer, current or former district court judge, circuit court judge, Court of Appeals judge, or Supreme Court justice carrying a concealed handgun under this section is not subject to the prohibitions and limitations of § 5-73-306.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 12-15-202, concerning certain persons who may carry a concealed handgun, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(f) A concealed handgun may be carried by a current or former district court judge, circuit court judge, Court of Appeals judge, or Supreme Court justice who:

(1) Is not otherwise prohibited under federal law from receiving or possessing a firearm; and

(2) Is not under the influence of or consuming alcohol or another intoxicating or hallucinatory drug or substance."
