17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-36-106(e), concerning the penalties for
20 and elements constituting theft by receiving, is amended to read as follows:

21 (e) Theft by receiving is a:

22 (1) Class B felony if the value of the property is twenty-five
23 thousand dollars (\$25,000) or more;

24 (2) Class C felony if:

25 (A) the The value of the property is less than twenty-five
26 thousand dollars (\$25,000) but more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or

27 (B) The property is a firearm valued at two thousand five
28 hundred dollars (\$2,500) or more;

29 (3) Class D felony if:

30 (A) The value of the property is five thousand dollars
31 (\$5,000) or less but more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000);

32 (B) The property is a:

33 (i) Credit card or credit card account number; ~~or~~

34 (ii) Debit card or debit card account number; or

35 (iii) Firearm valued at less than two thousand five
36 hundred dollars (\$2,500); or



(4) Class A misdemeanor if otherwise committed.
