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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-81-106(g), concerning which full-time	
22	law enforcement officers employed by the federal, state, county, or municip	al
23	government are empowered to effect an arrest, is amended to read as follows	; :
24	(g)(1) The following persons employed as full-time law enforcement	
25	officers by the federal, state, county, or municipal government who are	
26	empowered to effect an arrest with or without warrant for violations of the	÷
27	United States Code and who are authorized to carry firearms in the	
28	performance of their duties shall be empowered to act as officers for the	
29	arrest of offenders against the laws of this state and shall enjoy the same	<u> </u>
30	immunity, if any, to the same extent and under the same circumstances as	
31	certified state law enforcement officers:	
32	(A) Federal Bureau of Investigation special agents;	
33	(B) United States Secret Service special agents;	
34	(C) United States Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration	
35	Services special agents, investigators, and patrol officers;	
36	(D) United States Marshals Service deputies;	

1	(E) United States Drug Enforcement Administration special
2	agents;
3	(F) United States Postal Service postal inspectors and
4	special agents;
5	(G) United States Customs and Border Protection special
6	agents, inspectors, and patrol officers;
7	(H) United States General Services Administration special
8	agents;
9	(I) United States Department of Agriculture special
10	agents;
11	(J) United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and
12	Explosives special agents;
13	(K) Internal Revenue Service special agents and
14	inspectors;
15	(L) Certified law enforcement officers of the United
16	States Department of the Interior, National Park Service, and the United
17	States Fish and Wildlife Service;
18	(M) Members of federal, state, county, municipal, and
19	prosecuting attorneys' drug task forces;
20	(N) Certified law enforcement officers of the United
21	States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service; and
22	(0) United States Treasury Inspector General for Tax
23	Administration special agents; and
24	(P) Certified law enforcement officers of the Social
25	Security Administration.
26	(2) If an agency described in subdivision (g)(1) of this section
27	changes its name, the law enforcement officers described in subdivision
28	(g)(l) of this section that are employed by the agency remain empowered to
29	act as officers for the arrest of offenders against the laws of this state
30	and retain the same immunity, if any, to the same extent and under the same
31	circumstances as certified state law enforcement officers.
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
