15 TO PERMIT CERTAIN PERSONS TO POSSESS A
16 FIREARM IN A RETAIL LIQUOR STORE THAT
17 SELLS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF-
18 PREMISES CONSUMPTION; AND TO AMEND THE
19 LAW CONCERNING FIREARMS.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-403(21), concerning Class A alcoholic*
25 *beverage permit violations, is amended to read as follows:*

26 *(21)(A) Possession of a weapon on the permitted premises by a*
27 *person without a possessory or proprietary interest in the permitted*
28 *premises.*

29 *(B) When the permitted premises is a retail liquor store*
30 *that sells alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption, an employee of*
31 *the retail liquor store that is licensed to carry a concealed handgun by the*
32 *state may possess a handgun on the permitted premises if the possession of*
33 *the handgun is permitted under state law.*
