16 TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION
17 CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF ARKANSAS

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
22 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
23 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
26 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
27 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
28 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
29 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
30 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

32 SECTION 1. The purpose of this joint resolution is to amend the
33 Arkansas Constitution concerning the application of Arkansas law and United
34 States law for the purpose of protecting rights and privileges granted under
35 the United States Constitution and the Arkansas Constitution.
