The bill repeals statutory provisions:

- ! Prohibiting the possession of large-capacity ammunition magazines; and
- ! Requiring each large-capacity magazine that is manufactured in Colorado on or after July 1, 2013, to include a permanent stamp or marking indicating that the

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** part 3 of  
3 article 12 of title 18.

4           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
5 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
6 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
