Second Reading

1 Amend printed bill, page 176, after line 2, insert:

2 "SECTION 387. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 19-2.5-103, as  
3 added by Senate Bill 21-059 add (9) as follows:

4 19-2.5-103. [Formerly 19-2-104] Jurisdiction. (9) IF A JUVENILE  
5 IS CHARGED WITH A CIVIL INFRACTION AND IS NOT CHARGED WITH AN  
6 ADDITIONAL OFFENSE THAT WOULD CONSTITUTE A CRIMINAL OFFENSE IF  
7 CHARGED AGAINST AN ADULT, THE COUNTY COURT HAS JURISDICTION  
8 OVER THE CIVIL INFRACTION."

9 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

10 Page 355, strike lines 21 through 27.

11 Page 356, strike line 1.

12 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

13 Page 366, after line 16, insert:

14 "SECTION 798. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 11-61-102,  
15 amend as added by House Bill 21-1048 (3) as follows:

16 11-61-102. Retailers' acceptance of United States currency.  
17 (3) Failing to accept United States currency from a buyer as required by  
18 subsection (1) of this section is a ~~class 2 petty offense~~ CIVIL INFRACTION  
19 and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than two  
20 hundred fifty dollars per transaction or attempted transaction.

21 SECTION 799. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-1-126, amend  
22 as added by Senate Bill 21-135 (5) as follows:

23 33-1-126. Prohibiting certain animals in a traveling animal act  
24 - short title - definitions. (5) A person who violates this section is guilty  
25 of a AN UNCLASSIFIED misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall  
26 be punished by a fine of not less than two hundred fifty dollars and not  
27 more than one thousand dollars per violation."

28 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
