AN ACT CONCERNING THE LOCATION OF FIREARM TRAINING FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit a state agency
2 from constructing a firearms training facility in this state unless such
3 state agency (A) purchased or leased the property on which such
4 firearms training facility will be located prior to January 1, 2015, and
5 such property is not a state park, state forest or other public land open
6 to the public for active or passive recreation; (B) constructs such
7 firearms training facility on property owned or leased and used by the
8 federal or state government as a firearms training facility prior to
9 January 1, 2015; or (C) purchases or leases property on which such
10 firearms training facility will be located and such construction is
11 approved by the municipality within whose territorial limits such
12 firearms training facility is to be located, (2) require the Department of
13 Emergency Services and Public Protection to conduct a study
14 regarding its firearms training needs and identify property previously
15 considered for the construction of a firearms training facility as
16 deficient for such construction, and (3) prohibit the Department of
17 Administrative Services from entering into a contract to purchase or

18 lease real property for the purposes of constructing a firearms training
19 facility until the Department of Emergency Services and Public
20 Protection submits the study regarding its firearm training needs.

Statement of Purpose:

To limit the locations of state firearms training facilities and to direct the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection to conduct a study regarding its firearms training needs.
