AN ACT CONCERNING ERASED CRIMINAL RECORDS AND THE REVIEW OF FIREARM PERMIT APPLICATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That titles 29 and 54 of the general statutes be amended to permit
- 2 chiefs of police and the Board of Firearms Permit Examiners, in order to
- determine an applicant's suitability to hold a permit to carry a pistol or
- 4 revolver, to access records of arrests in the case of domestic violence
- 5 offenses that resulted in a nolle causing such arrest records to be subject
- 6 to erasure.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit chiefs of police and the Board of Firearms Permit Examiners to access arrest records resulting in a nolle in the case of a domestic violence offense in order to determine an applicant's suitability to hold a permit to carry a pistol or revolver.
