AN ACT CONCERNING TARGET PISTOLS DESIGNED FOR USE IN THE OLYMPIC GAMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subparagraphs (B) to (F), inclusive, of subdivision (1) of section
- 2 53-202a of the general statutes be amended to exclude from the
- 3 definition of "assault weapon" any .22 caliber rimfire target pistol that is
- 4 designed for use in target shooting events at the Olympic games
- 5 sponsored by the International Olympic Committee.

Statement of Purpose:

To exclude from the definition of "assault weapon" any rimfire target pistols that are designed for use in target shooting events at the Olympic games.
