**"AN ACT ADDRESSING GUN VIOLENCE."**

1 Strike lines 405 to 426, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(a) [The] (1) Until September 30, 2023, the fee for each permit  
4 originally issued under the provisions of subsection (a) of section 29-28,  
5 as amended by this act, for the sale at retail of [pistols and revolvers]  
6 firearms shall be two hundred dollars and for each renewal of such  
7 permit two hundred dollars. [The] Until September 30, 2023, the fee for  
8 each state permit originally issued under the provisions of subsection  
9 (b) of section 29-28, as amended by this act, for the carrying of pistols  
10 and revolvers shall be one hundred forty dollars plus sufficient funds as  
11 required to be transmitted to the Federal Bureau of Investigation to  
12 cover the cost of a national criminal history records check. Until  
13 September 30, 2023, the fee to renew each state permit originally issued  
14 under the provisions of subsection (b) of section 29-28, as amended by  
15 this act, shall be seventy dollars.

16       (2) On and after October 1, 2023, there shall be no fee for (A) any  
17 permit originally issued under the provisions of subsection (a) of section  
18 29-28, as amended by this act, for the sale at retail of firearms, or the  
19 renewal of such permit, or (B) any state permit originally issued under  
20 the provisions of subsection (b) of section 29-28, as amended by this act,  
21 for the carrying of pistols and revolvers or the renewal of such permit,  
22 except for sufficient funds as required to be transmitted to the Federal  
23 Bureau of Investigation to cover the cost of a national criminal history  
24 records check. The local authority shall forward sufficient funds for the  
25 national criminal history records check to the commissioner no later  
26 than five business days after receipt by the local authority of the  
27 application for the temporary state permit. [Seventy dollars shall be  
28 retained by the local authority. Upon approval by the local authority of  
29 the application for a temporary state permit, seventy dollars shall be  
30 sent to the commissioner. The fee to renew each state permit originally  
31 issued under the provisions of subsection (b) of section 29-28 shall be  
32 seventy dollars. Upon deposit of such fees in the General Fund, ten  
33 dollars of each fee shall be credited within thirty days to the  
34 appropriation for the Department of Emergency Services and Public  
35 Protection to a separate nonlapsing account for the purposes of the  
36 issuance of permits under subsections (a) and (b) of section 29-28.]"

37       After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
38 internal references accordingly:

39       "Sec. 501. Section 29-38o of the general statutes is repealed and the  
40 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):

41       (a) [The] (1) Until September 30, 2023, the fee for each ammunition  
42 certificate originally issued under the provisions of this section shall be  
43 thirty-five dollars and for each renewal thereof thirty-five dollars, which  
44 fees shall be paid to the Commissioner of Emergency Services and  
45 Public Protection and shall be in addition to the fee paid pursuant to  
46 subsection (b) of section 29-17a for conducting the national criminal  
47 history records check. [Upon deposit of such fees in the General Fund,  
48 the fees shall be credited to the appropriation to the Department of

49 Emergency Services and Public Protection to a separate nonlapsing  
50 account for the purposes of the issuance of ammunition certificates  
51 under section 29-38n.]

52 (2) On and after October 1, 2023, no fee shall be charged for each  
53 ammunition certificate originally issued under the provisions of this  
54 section or any renewal thereof, other than the fee paid pursuant to  
55 subsection (b) of section 29-17a for conducting the national criminal  
56 history records check.

57 (b) An ammunition certificate originally issued under the provisions  
58 of section 29-38n shall expire five years after the date it becomes effective  
59 and each renewal thereof shall expire five years after the expiration date  
60 of the certificate being renewed.

61 [(c) The renewal fee shall apply for each renewal that is requested not  
62 earlier than thirty-one days before, and not later than thirty-one days  
63 after, the expiration date of the certificate being renewed.]

64 [(d)] (c) No fee or portion thereof paid under the provisions of  
65 subsection (a) of this section for issuance or renewal of an ammunition  
66 certificate shall be refundable except if the certificate for which the fee  
67 or portion thereof was paid was not issued or renewed.

68 [(e)] (d) An ammunition certificate issued pursuant to section 29-38n  
69 shall be valid for a period of ninety days from the expiration date, except  
70 this provision shall not apply to any certificate which has been revoked  
71 or for which revocation is pending, pursuant to section 29-38p."
