**"AN ACT ADDRESSING GUN VIOLENCE."**

1 Strike section 15 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 15. Subsections (d) to (f), inclusive, of section 53-202f of the  
4 general statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu  
5 thereof (*Effective from passage*):

6 (d) [Not later than December 31, 2013, any] Any person who lawfully  
7 [possessed] possesses an assault weapon described in any provision of  
8 subparagraphs (B) to (F), inclusive, of subdivision (1) of section 53-202a,  
9 [on April 4, 2013, which was lawful under the provisions of sections 53-  
10 202a to 53-202k, inclusive, in effect on January 1, 2013,] as amended by  
11 this act, or a 2023 assault weapon may transfer possession of the assault  
12 weapon or 2023 assault weapon to (1) any member of such person's  
13 family who is not prohibited from owning a firearm, and (2) a licensed

14 gun dealer within or outside of this state for sale outside of this state,  
15 and may transport the assault weapon or 2023 assault weapon to such  
16 dealer for the purpose of making such transfer, without obtaining a  
17 certificate of possession under section 53-202d, as amended by this act.

18 (e) [Not later than October 1, 2013, any] Any licensed gun dealer,  
19 pawnbroker licensed under section 21-40, or consignment shop  
20 operator, as defined in section 21-39a, may transfer possession of an  
21 assault weapon or 2023 assault weapon to any person who (1) legally  
22 [possessed the] possesses an assault weapon [prior to or on April 4,  
23 2013] or 2023 assault weapon, (2) placed the assault weapon or 2023  
24 assault weapon in the possession of such dealer, pawnbroker or  
25 operator [prior to or on April 4, 2013,] pursuant to an agreement  
26 between such person and such dealer, pawnbroker or operator for the  
27 sale of the assault weapon or 2023 assault weapon to a third person, and  
28 (3) is eligible to possess a firearm on the date of such transfer.

29 (f) The term "licensed gun dealer", as used in sections 53-202a to 53-  
30 202k, inclusive, as amended by this act, means a person who has a  
31 federal firearms license and a permit to sell firearms pursuant to section  
32 29-28, as amended by this act."
