"AN ACT ADDRESSING GUN VIOLENCE."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (f) of section 54-124a of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*
5 *1, 2023*):

6 (f) The Board of Pardons and Paroles shall have independent
7 decision-making authority to (1) grant or deny parole in accordance
8 with sections 54-125, 54-125a, 54-125e and 54-125g, (2) establish
9 conditions of parole or special parole supervision in accordance with
10 section 54-126, (3) rescind or revoke parole or special parole in
11 accordance with sections 54-127 and 54-128, (4) grant commutations of
12 punishment or releases, conditioned or absolute, in the case of any
13 person convicted of any offense against the state [and commutations
14 from the penalty of death in accordance with section 54-130a] except for
15 those convicted in accordance with sections 53a-55a, 53a-56a, 53a-72b,

16 53a-92a, and 53a-94a, (5) discharge any person on parole or inmate
17 eligible for parole from the custody of the Commissioner of Correction
18 pursuant to section 54-129, and (6) terminate special parole in
19 accordance with section 54-129."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
