**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove lines 991-1002 and insert:

- 7 1. The fact that an employee or prospective employee holds
- 8 or does not hold a license issued pursuant to s. 790.06; or
- 9 2. Any agreement by an employee or a prospective employee
- 10 that prohibits an employee from keeping a legal firearm locked
- 11 inside or locked to a private motor vehicle in a parking lot
- 12 when such firearm is kept for lawful purposes.

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 14 This subsection applies to all public sector employers,  
 15 including those already prohibited from regulating firearms  
 16 under the provisions of s. 790.33. However, a person authorized

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17 to carry a concealed weapon or concealed firearm under s.  
18 790.01(1) may not store such a weapon or firearm in an  
19 automobile.
