

The Senate Judiciary Non-Civil Committee offered the following substitute to HB 60:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to carrying and possession of firearms, so as to provide an exemption
3 from certain laws regarding the carrying and possession of firearms by certain judges; to
4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

6 Part 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
7 relating to carrying and possession of firearms, is amended by revising paragraph (12) of
8 subsection (a) of Code Section 16-11-130, relating to exemptions from Code
9 Sections 16-11-126 through 16-11-127.2, as follows:

11 "(12) State, local, and federal ~~trial and appellate~~ judges, full-time and permanent
12 part-time judges of municipal and city courts, and such former ~~state trial and appellate~~
13 judges retired from or no longer serving in their respective offices ~~under state~~
14 ~~retirement~~;"

SECTION 2.

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
