A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 16-11-126 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 having or carrying handguns, long guns, or other weapons, license requirement, exceptions  
3 for homes, motor vehicles, private property, and other locations and conditions, so as to  
4 revise the requirements for the reciprocity of recognizing and giving effect to licenses to  
5 carry from other states; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for  
6 other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 16-11-126 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to having or  
10 carrying handguns, long guns, or other weapons, license requirement, exceptions for homes,  
11 motor vehicles, private property, and other locations and conditions, is amended by revising  
12 subsection (e) as follows:

13 "(e) Any person licensed to carry a ~~handgun~~ or weapon in any other state whose laws  
14 recognize and give effect to a license issued pursuant to this part shall be authorized to  
15 carry a weapon in this state, but only while the licensee is not a resident of this state;  
16 provided, however, that ~~such licensee~~:

17 (1) Such licensee licensed to carry a weapon in any other state shall carry the weapon in  
18 compliance with the laws of this state; and

19 (2) No other state shall be required to recognize and give effect to a license issued  
20 pursuant to this part that is held by a person who is younger than 21 years of age."

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
