A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to carrying and possession of firearms, so as to provide that information
- 3 relating to persons issued weapons carry licenses shall be confidential; to prohibit the
- 4 creation or maintenance of any data bases regarding persons issued weapons carry licenses;
- 5 to provide for verification of licenses; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective
- 6 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Part 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 10 relating to carrying and possession of firearms, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 "<u>16-11-129.1.</u>
- 13 (a) All records and information regarding persons issued weapons carry licenses
- maintained by the judge of the probate court shall be confidential and not subject to
- inspection or disclosure under Article 4 of Chapter 18 of Title 50.
- 16 (b) The state shall be prohibited from creating or maintaining a data base of information
- 17 <u>regarding persons issued weapons carry licenses.</u>
- 18 (c) The judge of the probate court of each county shall be authorized to verify only the
- 19 <u>legitimacy and validity of a weapons carry license, but shall not be authorized to provide</u>
- 20 <u>any further information regarding licensees."</u>
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 23 without such approval.
