A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 45-7-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to annual
2 salaries of certain state officials and cost-of-living adjustments, so as to repeal provisions
3 relating to the annual salaries of Supreme Court Justices, Court of Appeals Judges, superior
4 court judges and district attorneys; to enact provisions relating to the annual salaries of
5 Supreme Court Justices, Court of Appeals Judges, superior court judges and district
6 attorneys; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 Code Section 45-7-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to annual salaries
10 of certain state officials and cost-of-living adjustments, is amended by repealing in their
11 entirety paragraphs (18), (19), (20), and (21) of subsection (a) and enacting new paragraphs
12 (18), (19), (20), and (21) to read as follows:

13	<u>"(18) Each Justice of the Supreme Court</u>	<u>179,210.00</u>
14	<u>(19) Each Judge of the Court of Appeals</u>	<u>178,186.00</u>
15	<u>(20) Each superior court judge</u>	<u>132,252.00</u>
16	<u>Each superior court judge shall also receive any supplement paid to such</u>	
17	<u>judge by the county or counties of such judge's judicial circuit as may be</u>	
18	<u>provided for by law. Each superior court judge shall also receive</u>	
19	<u>reimbursement of travel expenses as provided by law.</u>	
20	<u>(21) Each district attorney</u>	<u>125,354.00</u>
21	<u>Each district attorney shall also receive any supplement paid to such district</u>	
22	<u>attorney by the county or counties of such district attorney's judicial circuit</u>	
23	<u>as may be provided for by law. Each district attorney shall also receive</u>	
24	<u>reimbursement of travel expenses as provided by law."</u>
