5 (3) This subsection shall not apply to any person providing a firearm to any other person
6 who has been:

7 (A) Pardoned for the felony by the President of the United States, the State Board of
8 Pardons and Paroles, or the person or agency empowered to grant pardons under the
9 constitutions or laws of any other state of the United States or of a foreign nation and,
10 by the terms of the pardon, has expressly been authorized to receive, possess, or
11 transport a firearm; or

12 (B) Otherwise granted relief from the disabilities of Code Section 16-11-131 pursuant
13 to subsections (c) and (d) of such Code section.
