A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to licenses, permits, and stamps for hunting, trapping, or fishing, so as to authorize
- 3 issuance of a special turkey-hunting permit for certain young and mobility impaired hunters;
- 4 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 6 SECTION 1.
- 7 Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 licenses, permits, and stamps for hunting, trapping, or fishing, is amended by adding a new
- 9 Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "27-2-4.4.
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'mobility impaired person' means any person
- who has been verified by a doctor of medicine currently licensed to practice by the Georgia
- Composite Medical Board, the State Board of Examiners in Osteopathy, or an equivalent
- body of another state to have any one of the following permanent conditions:
- 15 (1) Dependance upon a wheelchair or similar device for ambulation;
- 16 (2) Hemiplegia;
- 17 (3) Monoplegia;
- 18 (4) Paraplegia; or
- 19 (5) Single-leg amputation above the knee.
- 20 (b) The commissioner may issue special authorization to hunt turkeys during an extended
- 21 <u>open season to:</u>
- 22 (1) Any person who is 16 years of age or younger; or
- 23 (2) Any mobility impaired person.
- 24 (c) Any such special authorization shall be for the weekend prior to the first weekend of
- 25 <u>the open turkey season, as established by the department, and shall not be valid for</u>
- 26 <u>subsequent seasons unless reauthorization is approved.</u>

(d) Such special authorization shall be subject to all other provisions of this title, and the
 commissioner may impose any additional terms and conditions deemed necessary to

29 <u>implement the provisions of this Code section.</u>"
