4	COURAGE A SCHOOL DISTRICT TO ADOPT AN ELECTIVE COURSE IN FIREARMS SAFETY
5	EDUCATION AND TO AUTHORIZE INSTRUCTORS.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 16, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 33-1628, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

33-1628. FIREARMS SAFETY EDUCATION IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS. The board of trustees of a school district is encouraged to establish and maintain a firearms safety education course. The trustees may adopt an elective course of instruction developed by the department of fish and game, a law enforcement agency or a firearms association as its firearms safety education course. The course of instruction shall not permit the use or presence of live ammunition. Instructors from the department of fish and game, a law enforcement agency or a firearms organization as described in section 18-3302K(4)(c) (i), Idaho Code, shall be used to provide the instruction.
