AN ACT

1 RELATING TO FIREARMS, EXPLOSIVES, AND OTHER DEADLY WEAPONS; REPEALING SEC-
2 TION 18-3309, IDAHO CODE, RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY OF GOVERNING BOARDS
3 OF PUBLIC COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES REGARDING FIREARMS; AMENDING CHAP-
4 TER 33, TITLE 18, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 18-3309,
5 IDAHO CODE, TO PROHIBIT LIMITATIONS REGARDING CONCEALED WEAPONS AT PUB-
6 LIC COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING
7 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

10 SECTION 1. That Section [18-3309](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
11 repealed.

12 SECTION 2. That Chapter 33, Title 18, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
13 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-
14 ignated as Section 18-3309, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

15 18-3309. CONCEALED WEAPONS AT PUBLIC COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES. The
16 board of regents of the university of Idaho, the board of trustees of the
17 state colleges and universities, the board for career technical education,
18 and the boards of trustees of each of the community colleges established un-
19 der chapter 21, title 33, Idaho Code, shall not regulate or prohibit the oth-
20 erwise lawful possession, carrying, or transporting of firearms or ammuni-
21 tion by any person carrying a concealed weapon pursuant to section 18-3302,
22 18-3302H, or 18-3302K, Idaho Code.

23 SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
24 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
25 July 1, 2025.
