

SENATE BILL No. 350

DIGEST OF SB 350 (Updated February 16, 2015 10:52 am - DI 102)

Citations Affected: IC 20-23.

Synopsis: East Chicago school board. Reduces the number of members of the governing body of the School City of East Chicago from nine to five, beginning January 1, 2017. Provides that if a vacancy occurs on the governing body before January 1, 2017, the vacancy shall not be filled unless the vacancy reduces the number of members to fewer than five. Provides that members of the governing body are elected at large by the voters of the city. Repeals and provides for the expiration of statutes consistent with the new structure of the governing body.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

SENATE BILL No. 350

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 20-23-17.2-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.179-2011,
2	SECTION 31, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 3. (a) The governing body of the school
4	corporation consists of nine (9) members who shall be elected as
5	follows:
6	(1) One (1) member shall be elected from each of the school
7	districts described in section 4 of this chapter. A member elected
8	under this subdivision must reside within the boundaries of the
9	district the member represents.
10	(2) Three (3) members, who must reside within the boundaries of
11	the school corporation, shall be elected as at-large members.
12	(3) All members shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis.
13	(4) All members shall be elected at the general election held in
14	the county in 2012. and each four (4) years thereafter.
15	(b) Upon assuming office and in conducting the business of the
16	governing body, a member shall represent the interests of the entire



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1	school corporation.
2	(c) This section expires January 1, 2017.
3	SECTION 2. IC 20-23-17.2-3.1 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
4	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
5	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 3.1. (a) After December 31, 2016,
6	the governing body of the school corporation consists of five (5)
7	members, elected as follows:
8	
9	(1) At large by all the voters of the school corporation.(2) On a nonpartisan basis.

11	(3) At the general election held in the county in 2016 and every four (4) years thereafter.

13	(b) The term of office of a member of the governing body:
14	(1) is four (4) years; and (2) having January 1 after the election of members of the
15	(2) begins January 1 after the election of members of the
16	governing body.

19	entire school corporation.
	SECTION 3. IC 20-23-17.2-3.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
20	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
21	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 3.2. (a) Notwithstanding section
22	10 of this chapter, as in effect before July 1, 2015, and as amended
23	after June 30, 2015, if:
24	(1) a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of the
25	governing body after June 30, 2015; and
26	(2) the vacancy does not reduce the membership of the
27	governing body to fewer than five (5) members;
28	the vacancy shall not be filled.
29	(b) This section expires January 1, 2017.
30	SECTION 4. IC 20-23-17.2-4, AS ADDED BY P.L.179-2011,
31	SECTION 31, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
32	JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 4. (a) The boundaries of the districts from which
33	members of the governing body of the school corporation are elected
34	under section 3(a)(1) of this chapter are the same as the boundaries of
35	the common council districts of the city that are drawn under
36	IC 36-4-6.
37	(b) This section expires January 1, 2017.
38	SECTION 5. IC 20-23-17.2-5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.219-2013,
39	SECTION 88, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
40	JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 5. (a) The following apply to an election of
41	members of the governing body of the school corporation under section



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3(a)(1) of this chapter:

1	(1) Each candidate must file a petition of nomination with the
2	circuit court clerk not earlier than one hundred four (104) days
3	and not later than seventy-four (74) days before the general
4	election at which members are to be elected. The petition of
5	nomination must include the following information:
6	(A) The name of the candidate.
7	(B) The candidate's residence address and the district in which
8	the candidate resides.
9	(C) The signatures of at least twenty (20) registered voters
10	residing within the school corporation district the candidate
11	seeks to represent.
12	(D) A certification that the candidate meets the qualifications
13	for candidacy imposed by this chapter.
14	(2) Only eligible voters residing in the school corporation district
15	may vote for a candidate to represent that district.
16	(3) One (1) candidate shall be elected for each district. The
17	candidate elected for a district must reside within the boundaries
18	of the district. The candidate elected as the member for a
19	particular district is the candidate who, among all the candidates
20	who reside within that district, receives the greatest number of
21	votes from voters residing in that district.
22	(b) The following apply to an election of the members of the
23	governing body of the school corporation under section $\frac{3(a)(2)}{3.1}$ of
24	this chapter:
25	(1) Each candidate must file a petition of nomination with the
26	circuit court clerk not earlier than one hundred four (104) days
27	and not later than seventy-four (74) days before the general
28	election at which members are to be elected. The petition of
29	nomination must include the following information:
30	(A) The name of the candidate.
31	(B) The candidate's residence address.
32	(C) The signatures of at least one hundred (100) registered
33	voters residing within the school corporation.
34	(D) A certification that the candidate meets the qualifications
35	for candidacy imposed by this chapter.
36	(2) Only eligible voters residing in the school corporation may
37	vote for a candidate.
38	(3) Three (3) Five (5) candidates shall be elected at large. The
39	three (3) five (5) candidates who receive the greatest number of
40	votes among all candidates running for an at-large seat are elected
41	as members of the governing body.
42	SECTION 6. IC 20-23-17.2-6, AS ADDED BY P.L.179-2011,



1	SECTION 31, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
2	JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 6. Voters who reside within the boundaries of the
3	school corporation may vote for the candidates elected under section
4	3.1 of this chapter. Each voter may vote only for
5	(1) one (1) candidate to represent the district in which the voter
6	resides; and
7	(2) three (3) at-large five (5) candidates.
8	SECTION 7. IC 20-23-17.2-8 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY
9	1, 2015]. See. 8. (a) The term of each person elected to serve on the
10	governing body of the school corporation is four (4) years.
11	(b) The term of each person elected to serve on the governing body
12	begins on the date set in the school corporation's organization plan. The
13	date set in the organization plan for an elected member of the
14	governing body to take office may not be more than fourteen (14)
15	months after the date of the member's election. If the school
16	corporation's organization plan does not set a date for an elected
17	member of the governing body to take office, the member takes office
18	January 1 immediately following the person's election.
19	SECTION 8. IC 20-23-17.2-9, AS ADDED BY P.L.179-2011,
20	SECTION 31, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
21	JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 9. The members of the governing body of the
22	school corporation shall be elected at the general election to be held in
23	2012 2016 and every four (4) years thereafter.
