ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1004

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **As used in this**
2 **SECTION, "commission" refers to the prekindergarten and early**
3 **learning study commission established by subsection (b).**
4 (b) **The prekindergarten and early learning study commission**
5 **is established.**
6 (c) **The legislative council established by IC 2-5-1.1-1 shall**
7 **determine the number of members to appoint to the commission.**
8 **The members of the commission may consist of legislators and lay**
9 **members. The legislative council shall specify the number of**
10 **legislative members and lay members. The lay members must have**
11 **expertise in the area of education, business, childhood**
12 **development, or social services.**
13 (d) **The chairman of the legislative council shall appoint the**
14 **chairperson of the commission. The vice chairman of the legislative**
15 **council shall appoint a member of the commission to serve as vice**
16 **chairperson of the commission. The chairman and vice chairman**

1 of the legislative council each shall appoint one-half (1/2) of the
2 remaining members of the commission. If there is an odd number
3 of members of the commission, the chairman of the legislative
4 council appoints one (1) more member than the vice chairman of
5 the legislative council.

6 (e) If a vacancy occurs on the commission, the legislative council
7 shall appoint an individual to fill the vacancy.

8 (f) The commission shall do the following:

9 (1) Study the feasibility of obtaining a block grant and
10 necessary waivers under the federal Head Start program
11 under 42 U.S.C. 9831 et seq. to establish an early learning
12 scholarship program or another type of alternative program.

13 (2) Study the feasibility of obtaining a Child Care and
14 Development Block Grant under 42 U.S.C. 9858 et seq. or
15 other federal funds to fund prekindergarten or early learning
16 education programs in Indiana.

17 (3) Study options for funding prekindergarten or early
18 learning programs, including opportunities to partner with
19 businesses, philanthropic, or community leaders.

20 (4) Review whether other states have developed rigorous
21 accountability standards for prekindergarten or early
22 learning programs.

23 (5) Study parental involvement opportunities to prepare
24 children for education outside the educational environment,
25 including the benefits of reading to a child.

26 (6) Study opportunities to equip parents with skills necessary
27 to improve the parent's ability to contribute to their child's
28 early education.

29 (7) Study the economic benefits of prekindergarten or early
30 learning programs.

31 (8) Study the appropriate state agency or entity to oversee and
32 develop early learning accountability standards.

33 (9) Determine the appropriate income standard to use to
34 determine whether a parent is eligible to receive assistance
35 from the state for prekindergarten or early learning
36 programs.

37 (10) Study opportunities to partner with an investment group
38 or entity to establish an investment fund or vehicle to finance
39 early education in Indiana.

40 (g) The commission shall submit a final report of the results of
41 its study and any recommendations to the legislative council before
42 November 1, 2014. The report must be in an electronic format

is less than the passage rate determined by the early learning advisory committee under IC 12-17.2-3.6-9(a)(5)."
