3	Whereas, The National Main Street Center was established
4	by the National Trust for Historic Preservation in 1980;
5	Whereas, Since its inception, the center has grown to
6	become the largest full-service commercial district
7	revitalization organization in the nation;
8	Whereas, Recognizing the crucial role the downtown
9	business district plays in the overall image of a community, the
0	Indiana General Assembly established the Indiana Main Street
1	program in 1985 to encourage the economic development,
2	redevelopment, and improvement of downtown areas in Indiana
3	cities and towns;
4	Whereas, Indiana Main Street is advised by the Main Street
5	Advisory Council, a public/private advisory board appointed by
6	Lieutenant Governor Sue Ellspermann;
7	Whereas, Indiana Main Street emphasizes building local
8	capacity and self-sufficiency through technical assistance and
9	encourages local businesses, residents, and leaders to get
20	involved in community projects;

1	Whereas, In order to address all the needs of the
2	community, Indiana Main Street uses the National Main Street
3	Center's four point approach for improving downtown areas:
4	design, organization, promotion, and economic restructuring;
5	Whereas, The National Main Street revitalization project
6	has proven to be one of the most successful economic
7	development strategies in America;
8	Whereas, Research has shown that, on a national average,
9	for every dollar spent to operate a local Main Street program,
10	approximately thirty-three dollars has been reinvested in the
11	community;
12	Whereas, Numerous local communities throughout Indiana
13	have benefitted from the Indiana Main Street program's
14	services to revitalize downtown communities over the past
15	thirty years, with 121 communities currently participating; and
16	Whereas, The Indiana General Assembly expresses sincere
17	gratitude to the Indiana Main Street program for its ongoing
18	efforts to renew downtown business districts throughout
19	Indiana: Therefore,
20	Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly
