SENATE RESOLUTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION honoring Virgil Ray Hudnall
2	for his years of dedicated service to his country and his state.
3	Whereas, Born on April 1, 1926, Virgil Ray Hudnall served
4	his country in the United States Army during World War II, the
5	Korean War, and the Vietnam War;
6	Whereas, Virgil Ray Hudnall is one of an estimated 33,890
7	three-war veterans alive today;
8	Whereas, All Three Wars, a veterans' organization, lists
9	only one other Indiana resident as a member;
10	Whereas, Because of his great love for and commitment to
11	this country, Virgil Ray Hudnall spent a large portion of his life
12	away from his beloved family serving his country;
13	Whereas, Virgil Ray Hudnall's military career began as an
14	assignment to the 310th Infantry, of the 78th Lightning Division,
15	in February 1945:

1	Whereas, During WWII, Virgil Ray Hudnall experienced
2	daily combat in Germany from March 1945 until the conclusion
3	of the war on May 8, 1945;
4	Whereas, During his service in WWII, Virgil Ray Hudnall
5	spent his 19th birthday manning a Browning Water Cooled
6	machine gun in a foxhole along the Sieg Canal;
7	Whereas, Also during WWII, Virgil Ray Hudnall captured
8	two German soldiers and turned them over to a POW camp
9	unharmed;
10	Whereas, Virgil Ray Hudnall was Honorably Discharged
11	from the U.S. Army on July 31, 1946;
12	Whereas, Virgil Ray Hudnall was awarded the Good
13	Conduct Medal, Army Occupational Medal, European African
14	Middle Eastern Theater Ribbon, and the WWII Victory Ribbon;
15	Whereas, After reenlisting with the Army, Virgil Ray
16	Hudnall was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant;
17	Whereas, Virgil Ray Hudnall commanded the G2 Division
18	of the 40th Infantry Headquarters during the Korean War;
19	Whereas, Virgil Ray Hudnall began serving in Vietnam in
20	July 1972 and was assigned to the MACV Advisory Group,
21	advising South Vietnamese Training Command;
22	Whereas, Virgil Ray Hudnall was again Honorably
23	Discharged from the U.S. Army on June 30, 1976, at the rank
24	of Lieutenant Colonel; and
25	Whereas, Virgil Ray Hudnall's selfless acts of courage
26	throughout these three wars has earned him the title of
27	American hero: Therefore,



1	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
2	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
3	SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate wishes to recognize the
4	commitment to service displayed by Virgil Ray Hudnall in the United
5	States Army by dedicating more than 25 years of his life to serving and
6	defending his country to the best of his abilities.
7	SECTION 2. That the Secretary of the Senate is hereby directed
8	to transmit a copy of this Resolution to Virgil Ray Hudnall and his
9	family.
