

SENATE BILL No. 361

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-31.5-2; IC 35-47.

Synopsis: Regulation of assault weapons. Makes it a Level 6 felony for a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, licensed dealer, or licensed collector to knowingly or intentionally sell or deliver a semiautomatic assault weapon or a large capacity ammunition feeding device to a person who is less than 21 years of age. Specifies defenses and exceptions. Defines terms.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

22 **(i) armed forces of the United States; or**

23 **(ii) national guard; or**

24 **(B) state or local law enforcement officer;**

25 **who possesses or is armed with a weapon or device described**
26 **in section 17 of this chapter in the line of duty;**

27 **(3) receives by inheritance of title but does not possess a**
28 **weapon or device described in section 17 of this chapter; or**

29 **(4) possesses a weapon or device described in section 17 of this**
30 **chapter to defend against an intruder at:**

31 **(A) the person's residence; or**

32 **(B) another person's residence at which the person is an**
33 **invited guest.**

34 **Sec. 2. (a) As used in this chapter, and except as provided in**
35 **subsection (b), "barrel shroud" means a shroud that:**

36 **(1) is attached to; or**

37 **(2) partially or completely encircles;**

38 **the barrel of a firearm so that the shroud protects the user of the**
39 **firearm from heat generated by the barrel.**

40 **(b) The term defined in subsection (a) does not include:**

41 **(1) a slide that partially or completely encloses the barrel; or**

42 **(2) an extension of the stock along the bottom of the barrel**



1 that does not encircle or substantially encircle the barrel.

2 **Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "belt-fed semiautomatic**
3 **firearm" means a repeating firearm that:**

4 (1) uses a portion of the energy of a firing cartridge to:

5 (A) extract the fired cartridge case; and

6 (B) chamber the next round;

7 (2) requires a separate pull of the trigger to fire each
8 cartridge; and

9 (3) has the capacity to accept a belt ammunition feeding
10 device.

11 **Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "detachable magazine" means an**
12 **ammunition feeding device that can be removed from a firearm**
13 **without disassembly of the firearm action.**

14 **Sec. 5. As used in this chapter, "fixed magazine" means an**
15 **ammunition feeding device that is permanently fixed to the firearm**
16 **in such a manner that it cannot be removed without disassembly of**
17 **the firearm.**

18 **Sec. 6. As used in this chapter, "folding, telescoping, or**
19 **detachable stock" means a stock that folds, telescopes, detaches, or**
20 **otherwise operates to:**

21 (1) reduce the length, size, or any other dimension of; or

22 (2) otherwise enhance the ability to conceal;

23 a firearm.

24 **Sec. 7. As used in this chapter, "forward grip" means a grip**
25 **located forward of the trigger that functions as a pistol grip.**

26 **Sec. 8. As used in this chapter, "grenade launcher" means an**
27 **attachment for use on a firearm that is designed to propel a**
28 **grenade or other similar destructive device.**

29 **Sec. 9. (a) As used in this chapter, and except as provided in**
30 **subsection (b), "large capacity ammunition feeding device" means**
31 **a magazine, belt, drum, feed strip, or similar device, including a**
32 **device joined or coupled with another in any manner, that:**

33 (1) has an overall capacity of; or

34 (2) can be readily restored, changed, or converted to accept;
35 more than ten (10) rounds of ammunition.

36 (b) The term defined in subsection (a) does not include an
37 attached tubular device that is:

38 (1) designed to accept; and

39 (2) capable of operating only with;
40 .22 caliber rimfire ammunition.

41 **Sec. 10. As used in this chapter, "licensed importer, licensed**
42 **manufacturer, licensed dealer, or licensed collector" has the**



1 meaning set forth in 18 U.S.C. 921(a) corresponding to each term,
2 as applicable.

3 **Sec. 11.** As used in this chapter, "pistol grip" means a grip, a
4 thumbhole stock or Thordsen-type grip or stock, or any other
5 characteristic that can function as a grip.

6 **Sec. 12.** As used in this chapter, "semiautomatic assault
7 weapon" means any of the following, regardless of the country of
8 manufacture or the caliber of ammunition accepted:

9 (1) A semiautomatic rifle that has the capacity to accept a
10 detachable magazine and at least one (1) of the following:

11 (A) A pistol grip.

12 (B) A forward grip.

13 (C) A folding, telescoping, or detachable stock.

14 (D) A capability to be otherwise foldable or adjustable in
15 a manner that:

16 (i) operates to reduce the length, size, or any other
17 dimension of; or

18 (ii) otherwise enhances the ability to conceal;

19 the weapon.

20 (E) A grenade launcher.

21 (F) A barrel shroud.

22 (G) A threaded barrel.

23 (2) A semiautomatic rifle that has a fixed magazine with the
24 capacity to accept more than ten (10) rounds. This subdivision
25 does not include an attached tubular device that is:

26 (A) designed to accept; and

27 (B) capable of operating only with;

28 .22 caliber rimfire ammunition.

29 (3) A part, combination of parts, component, device,
30 attachment, or accessory that:

31 (A) is designed; or

32 (B) functions;

33 to accelerate the rate of fire of a semiautomatic rifle but not
34 convert the semiautomatic rifle into a machine gun.

35 (4) A semiautomatic pistol that has the capacity to accept a
36 detachable magazine and:

37 (A) has:

38 (i) a threaded barrel;

39 (ii) a second pistol grip;

40 (iii) a barrel shroud;

41 (iv) the capacity to accept a detachable magazine at some
42 location outside of the pistol grip;
