1 AN ACT concerning crimes, criminal procedure and punishment; relating
2 to possession of a firearm during commission of a misdemeanor.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) Criminal possession of a firearm during a misdemeanor
6 is:

7 (1) Having a firearm on one's person or within such person's
8 immediate control during the commission of:

9 (A) Any violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5411, and amendments
10 thereto;

11 (B) a misdemeanor violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5412, and
12 amendments thereto;

13 (C) a misdemeanor violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5413, and
14 amendments thereto;

15 (D) a misdemeanor violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5427, and
16 amendments thereto;

17 (E) any violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5429, and amendments
18 thereto;

19 (F) a misdemeanor violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5505, and
20 amendments thereto;

21 (G) a misdemeanor violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5706, and
22 amendments thereto;

23 (H) a misdemeanor violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5801, and
24 amendments thereto;

25 (I) any violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5808, and amendments
26 thereto;

27 (J) a misdemeanor violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5924, and
28 amendments thereto; or

29 (K) any violation of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-6203, and amendments
30 thereto.

31 (b) (1) Criminal possession of a firearm during a misdemeanor is a
32 class A misdemeanor.

33 (2) In addition to any other sentence imposed, a person convicted of
34 criminal possession of a firearm during a misdemeanor shall be fined
35 \$2,500.
