Amendments proposed by Representative McCormick to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 130  
by Senator Morris

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 3 through 5 in  
3 their entirety and insert the following:

4 "R.S. 14:95(M)(1) and (2) and R.S. 40:1379.3(B)(2)(a), 1379.3.3(B), (D)(1)  
5 and (6), and (F)(2), to enact R.S. 14:95(N) and R.S. 40:1379.3.3(D)(9), and to repeal  
6 R.S. 14:95(M)(3), relative to the illegal carrying of weapons; to exempt certain  
7 persons from the crime of illegal carrying of weapons; to provide relative to  
8 concealed handgun permits; to provide relative to the authority of a person to carry  
9 a concealed handgun without a permit; to provide for a restriction; to provide relative  
10 to an online education course; to provide relative to course topics; and to provide for  
11 related matters."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 2

13 On page 1, line 7, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and delete line 8 in its  
14 entirety and insert the following:

15 "R.S. 14:95(M)(1) and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.  
16 14:95(N) is hereby enacted to read as follows:"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 3

18 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 17 in their entirety and delete page 2 in its entirety and  
19 insert the following:

20 "M. The provisions of Paragraph (A)(1) of this Section shall not apply to a  
21 ~~resident of Louisiana~~ **person** if all of the following conditions are met:

- 22 (1) The person is ~~twenty-one~~ **eighteen** years of age or older.
- 23 (2) The person is not prohibited from possessing a firearm under R.S.  
24 14:95.1, ~~R.S. 40:1379.3(C)(5) through (17), 18 U.S.C. 922(g), or any other state or~~  
25 federal law.

27 **N. Any person carrying a weapon pursuant to Subsection M of this**  
28 **Section shall be subject to the restrictions contained in R.S. 40:1379.3(M) and**  
29 **(N).**

30 Section 2. R.S. 40:1379.3(B)(2)(a) and 1379.3.3(B), (D)(1) and (6), and (F)(2) are  
31 hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 40:1379.3.3(D)(9) is hereby enacted to read as  
32 follows:

33 §1379.3. Statewide permits for concealed handguns; application procedures;

38 (2)(a) A ~~Louisiana resident~~ **person** who meets the qualifications of R.S.  
39 14:95(M) shall not be required to possess a valid concealed handgun permit issued

1 by the state of Louisiana pursuant to the provisions of this Section in order to carry  
2 a concealed handgun in the state of Louisiana. ~~The provisions of this Paragraph shall~~  
3 ~~not affect the requirements of reciprocity as provided in Subsection T of this Section.~~

7 B. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of state police,  
8 shall provide a ~~two-hour~~ **two hour and fifteen-minute** online handgun education  
9 course at no cost to Louisiana residents.

11 D. The online handgun education course shall include instruction on all of  
12 the following topics:

13 (1) Handgun basics and nomenclature, **including handling procedures for**  
14 **a revolver and a semiautomatic pistol.**

16 (6) Accident prevention, **including safe storage of firearms.**

18 **(9) Suicide prevention, with an emphasis on the impact of firearm-**  
19 **related suicides involving veterans and current service members of the United**  
20 **States Armed Forces.**

24 (2) In accordance with Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, the Department of  
25 Public Safety and Corrections, office of state police, shall divide the topics provided  
26 in Subsection D of this Section into ~~eight~~ **nine** video segments that shall broadcast  
27 for no less than fifteen minutes per segment.

28 Section 3. R.S. 14:95(M)(3) is hereby repealed in its entirety."
