Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary C to Original Senate Bill No. 132

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 2 through 5 and insert the following:

3 "To amend and reenact R.S. 14:95.2.1(A) and 95.2.2(C)(2), relative to offenses affecting the
4 public; to provide relative to the crimes of illegally carrying of a firearm at a parade
5 and reckless discharge of a firearm at a parade; to provide relative to penalties; to
6 provide relative to exceptions; and to provide for related matters."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 2

8 On page 1, line 7, after "14:95.2.1(A)" delete "is" and insert "and 95.2.2(C)(2) are"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 1, delete lines 15 and 16, and insert the following:

11 "year nor more than five years, or both. **The entire sentence of imprisonment, not**
12 **to exceed the first three years for sentences greater than three years, shall be**
13 **served without benefit of parole, probation, or**"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 4

15 On page 2, after line 4, insert the following:

16 "§95.2.2. Reckless discharge of a firearm at a parade or demonstration
17 * * *
18 C. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to:
19 * * *
20 (2) The possession of a firearm occurring within one thousand feet of a public
21 gathering entirely within a private residence or in accordance with a concealed
22 handgun permit issued pursuant to R.S. 40:1379.1 **and 1379.3.**"
