An Act repealing the ban on modern sporting arms.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 121 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking, in lines 9 through 35, inclusive, the definition of  
3 “Assault weapon”.

4 SECTION 2. Section 123 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking, in lines 131 through 134, inclusive, the  
6 following:

7 “Sixteenth, That no licensee shall sell, lease, rent, transfer or deliver or offer for sale,  
8 lease, rent, transfer or delivery to any person any assault weapon or large capacity feeding device  
9 that was not otherwise lawfully possessed on September 13, 1994.”.

10 SECTION 3. Section 131M of chapter 140, as so appearing, is hereby repealed.
