Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 23 of Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws shall be amended by inserting the following language at the end of the section:
- Notwithstanding any special law or regulation to the contrary nothing in this section shall
- 4 be deemed as requiring a company outside of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to be
- 5 required to be licensed under this section. Said companies shall be entitled to sell and deliver
- 6 inert ammunition components to persons properly licensed to possess or purchase ammunition
- 7 under sections, 129B or 131 of this chapter, through the internet, U.S. Mail or by any other
- 8 means common to interstate commerce. All deliveries of ammunition under this paragraph,

- 9 whether in person or by common carrier, must require the signature of the licensee and
- 10 photographic identification.
- For the purposes of this section the term "inert components" shall include, but not be
- limited to the following: cases, bullets, shot, wads.
