1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to the legislature; establishing certain requirements for members proposing  
1.3 firearms legislation; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter  
1.4 3.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [3.183] FIREARM BILL; REQUIREMENTS.

1.7 (a) A member of the legislature who introduces or authors a bill relating to firearms  
1.8 must provide proof, upon request, that the member of the legislature introducing or authoring  
1.9 the bill: (1) possesses a valid permit issued under section 624.714 or a firearms safety  
1.10 certificate issued under section 97B.015, subdivision 5; (2) has successfully completed  
1.11 range safety officer training; and (3) has successfully completed a knowledge test regarding  
1.12 firearm calibers and gauges.

1.13 (b) For purposes of this section, "firearm" has the meaning given in section 97A.015,  
1.14 subdivision 19.
