AN ACT

To repeal section 57.111, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 57.111, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu
2 thereof, to be known as section 57.111, to read as follows:

57.111. Whenever any sheriff or deputy sheriff of any county in this state is expressly
2 requested, in each instance, by a sheriff [of an adjoining county] of this state to render assistance,
3 such sheriff or deputy shall have the same powers of arrest in such county as he **or she** has in his
4 **or her** own jurisdiction. **The county where the sheriff or deputy sheriff rendering assistance**
5 **is employed shall be responsible for workers' compensation insurance, overtime, expense**
6 **reimbursement, and any and all other liability incurred as part of providing assistance in**
7 **the requesting county.**
