AN ACT

To amend chapter 571, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to firearm buyback programs, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 571, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 571.520, to read as follows:

571.520. 1. As used in this section, "firearm buyback program" means a program

- to purchase or accept donations of privately owned firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition
- from private individuals or organizations for the purpose of reducing the number of
- firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition owned by civilians or for the purpose of permitting the individual or organization to sell or donate a firearm to the government without fear
- of prosecution. "Firearm buyback program" shall not include the purchase of a firearm,
- firearm part, or ammunition from a licensed firearms dealer and shall not include a
- program to purchase firearms, firearm parts, or ammunition for law enforcement purposes.
- 10 2. Neither the state nor any agency or political subdivision thereof nor any law 11 enforcement agency therein shall conduct a firearm buyback program or participate in the 12 implementation, administration, or operation of a firearm buyback program.
- 13 3. Neither the state nor any agency or political subdivision thereof nor any law 14 enforcement agency therein shall expend any public funds for the purpose of implementing, administering, or otherwise operating a firearm buyback program. 15

4. Any person who violates this section while acting in an official capacity on behalf

17 of the state or an agency or political subdivision thereof or a law enforcement agency

18 therein shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
