1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 602, Page 2, Section 1.1000, Line 26, by  
2 inserting the following after all of said section and line:

4 "Section 1. 1. No entity in this state shall require documentation of an individual having  
5 received a vaccination against any disease in order for the individual to access transportation  
6 systems or services, including but not limited to buses, air travel, rail travel, taxicab or limousine  
7 services, prearranged rides as defined in section 387.400, other public transportation, or any public  
8 transportation facilities, including but not limited to bus and airport facilities.

9 2. No entity of the state or its political subdivisions or any publicly-funded entity in the  
10 state shall require a COVID-19 passport to enter a public building or to access public services.

11 3. No Missouri government entity, subdivision, agency, or agent, is authorized to issue  
12 vaccine passports, vaccine passes, or other standardized documentation for the purpose of certifying  
13 an individual's COVID-19 vaccination status to a third party, or otherwise publish or share any  
14 individual's COVID-19 vaccination record or similar health information.

15 4. Missouri business entities are prohibited from requiring patrons or customers to provide  
16 any documentation certifying COVID-19 vaccination or post-transmission recovery to gain access  
17 to, entry upon, or service from the business entity.

18 5. All businesses must comply with this act to be eligible for state tax credits or for grants or  
19 contracts funded through state revenue.

20 6. The requirements in this act do not otherwise restrict businesses from instituting COVID-  
21 19 screening protocols in accordance with state and federal law to protect public health, and nothing  
22 herein shall be construed to interfere with individuals' rights to access their own personal health  
23 information under federal law.

24 7. Nothing in this section shall prohibit or discourage residents of Missouri who wish to  
25 voluntarily obtain a third-party or commercially-produced vaccination passport for any out-of-state  
26 travel purposes from doing so."; and

28 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
29 accordingly.
