Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 46, Page 1, Section TITLE, Line 4,

2	by striking "vehicles" and inserting in lieu thereof the
3	following: "transportation"; and
4	Further amend said bill, page 4, Section 301.558, line
5	106, by inserting after all of said line the following:
6	"306.030. 1. The owner of each vessel requiring
7	numbering by this state shall file an application for number
8	with the department of revenue on forms provided by it. The
9	application shall contain a full description of the vessel,
10	factory number or serial number, together with a statement
11	of the applicant's source of title and of any liens or
12	encumbrances on the vessel. For good cause shown the
13	director of revenue may extend the period of time for making
14	such application. The director of revenue shall use
15	reasonable diligence in ascertaining whether the facts
16	stated in such application are true, and, if satisfied that
17	the applicant is the lawful owner of such vessel, or
18	otherwise entitled to have the same registered in his or her
19	name, shall thereupon issue an appropriate certificate of
20	title over the director's signature and sealed with the seal
21	of the director's office, procured and used for such
22	purpose, and a certificate of number stating the number
23	awarded to the vessel. The application shall include a
24	provision stating that the applicant will consent to any
25	inspection necessary to determine compliance with the
26	provisions of this chapter and shall be signed by the owner

- of the vessel and shall be accompanied by the fee specified
- in subsection 10 of this section. The owner shall paint on
- 29 or attach to each side of the bow of the vessel the
- 30 identification number in a manner as may be prescribed by
- 31 rules and regulations of the division of water safety in
- 32 order that it may be clearly visible. The number shall be
- 33 maintained in legible condition. The certificate of number
- 34 shall be pocket size and shall be available at all times for
- inspection on the vessel for which issued, whenever the
- 36 vessel is in operation. The operator of a vessel in which
- 37 such certificate of number is not available for inspection
- 38 by the water patrol division or, if the operator cannot be
- 39 determined, the person who is the registered owner of the
- 40 vessel shall be subject to the penalties provided in section
- 41 306.210. Vessels owned by the state or a political
- 42 subdivision shall be registered but no fee shall be assessed
- 43 for such registration.
- 44 2. Each new vessel sold in this state after January 1,
- 45 1970, shall have die stamped on or within three feet of the
- 46 transom or stern a factory number or serial number.
- 47 3. The owner of any vessel already covered by a number
- 48 in full force and effect which has been awarded to it
- 49 pursuant to then operative federal law or a federally
- 50 approved numbering system of another state shall record the
- 51 number prior to operating the vessel on the waters of this
- 52 state in excess of the sixty-day reciprocity period provided
- 53 for in section 306.080. The recordation and payment of
- 54 registration fee shall be in the manner and pursuant to the
- 55 procedure required for the award of a number under
- 56 subsection 1 of this section. No additional or substitute
- 57 number shall be issued unless the number is a duplicate of
- 58 an existing Missouri number.

- 4. In the event that an agency of the United States government shall have in force an overall system of identification numbering for vessels within the United States, the numbering system employed pursuant to this chapter by the department of revenue shall be in conformity therewith.
- 5. All records of the department of revenue made and kept pursuant to this section shall be public records.
- 67 A permanent certificate of number may be issued 68 upon application and payment of three times the fee specified for the vessel under this section and three times 69 70 any processing fee applicable to a three-year certificate of 71 number for the vessel. Permanent certificates of number 72 shall not be transferred to any other person or vessel, or 73 displayed on any vessel other than the vessel for which it 74 was issued, and shall continue in force and effect until 75 terminated or discontinued in accordance with the provisions 76 of this chapter. Every other certificate of number awarded 77 pursuant to this chapter shall continue in force and effect for a period of three years unless sooner terminated or 78 79 discontinued in accordance with the provisions of this 80 chapter. Certificates of number may be renewed by the owner in the same manner provided for in the initial securing of 81 82 the same or in accordance with the provisions of sections 306.010 to 306.030. 83
 - 7. The department of revenue shall fix the days and months of the year on which certificates of number due to expire during the calendar year shall lapse and no longer be of any force and effect unless renewed pursuant to this chapter and may stagger such dates in order to distribute the workload.
- 90 8. When applying for or renewing a vessel's 91 certificate of number, the owner shall submit a paid

personal property tax receipt for the tax year which immediately precedes the year in which the application is made or the year in which the renewal is due and which reflects that the vessel being renewed is listed as personal property and that all personal property taxes, including delinquent taxes from prior years, have been paid, or a statement certified by the county or township in which the owner's property was assessed showing that the state and county tangible personal property taxes for such previous tax year and all delinquent taxes due have been paid by the applicant or that no such taxes were due.

9. When applying for or renewing a certificate of registration for a vessel documented with the United States Coast Guard under section 306.016, owners of vessels shall submit a paid personal property tax receipt for the tax year which immediately precedes the year in which the application is made or the renewal is due and which reflects that the vessel is listed as personal property and that all personal property taxes, including delinquent taxes from prior years, have been paid, or a statement certified by the county or township in which the owner's property was assessed showing that the state and county tangible personal property taxes for such previous tax year and all delinquent taxes due have been paid by the applicant or that no such taxes were due.

10. The fee to accompany each application for a certificate of number is:

- 124 11. The certificate of title and certificate of number 125 issued by the director of revenue shall be manufactured in a 126 manner to prohibit as nearly as possible the ability to 127 alter, counterfeit, duplicate, or forge such certificate 128 without ready detection.
- 129 12. For fiscal years ending before July 1, 2019, the first two million dollars collected annually under the 130 provisions of this section shall be deposited into the state 131 general revenue fund. All fees collected under the 132 provisions of this section in excess of two million dollars 133 annually shall be deposited in the water patrol division 134 fund and shall be used exclusively for the water patrol 135 136 division.
- 13. Beginning July 1, 2019, the first one million
 138 dollars collected annually under the provisions of this
 139 section shall be deposited into the state general revenue
 140 fund. All fees collected under the provisions of this
 141 section in excess of one million dollars annually shall be
 142 deposited in the water patrol division fund and shall be
 143 used exclusively for the water patrol division.
- 14. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 10 of
 this section, vessels at least sixteen feet in length but
 less than twenty-eight feet in length, that are homemade,
 constructed out of wood, and have a beam of five feet or
 less, shall pay a fee of fifty-five dollars which shall
 accompany each application for a certification number."; and
 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
