1 AMEND House Bill No. 282, Page 10, Section 571.030, Line 186, by inserting after all of said
2 section and line the following:

4 "571.070. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful possession of a firearm if such
5 person knowingly has any firearm in his or her possession and:

6 (1) Such person has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this state[;] or of a crime
7 under the laws of any state or of the United States [~~which~~] that, if committed within this state, would
8 be a felony; [~~or~~]

9 (2) Such person is under eighteen years of age, is on public property, is not accompanied by
10 an adult twenty-one years of age or older, and is not possessing the firearm as otherwise allowed by
11 law; or

12 (3) Such person is a fugitive from justice, is habitually in an intoxicated or drugged
13 condition, or is currently adjudged mentally incompetent.

14 2. Unlawful possession of a firearm is a class D felony, unless a person has been convicted
15 of a dangerous felony as defined in section 556.061, in which case it is a class C felony.

16 3. The provisions of subdivision (1) of subsection 1 of this section shall not apply to the
17 possession of an antique firearm."; and
