## SENATE BILL NO. 106

## AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to patient examinations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows: Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto 2 one new section, to be known as section 191.240, to read as 3 follows: 191.240. 1. For purposes of this section, the 2 following terms mean: "Health care provider", the same meaning given to 3

- 4 the term in section 191.900;
- 5 "Patient examination", a prostate, anal, or pelvic 6 examination.
- 7 2. A health care provider, or any student or trainee under the supervision of a health care provider, shall not 8 9 knowingly perform a patient examination upon an anesthetized or unconscious patient in a health care facility unless: 10
  - The patient or a person authorized to make health care decisions for the patient has given specific informed consent to the patient examination for nonmedical purposes;
- 14 (2) The patient examination is necessary for diagnostic or treatment purposes; 15

(3) The collection of evidence through a forensic 16 17 examination, as defined under subsection 8 of section 595.220, for a suspected sexual assault on the anesthetized 18 19 or unconscious patient is necessary because the evidence

- will be lost or the patient is unable to give informedconsent due to a medical condition; or
- 22 (4) Circumstances are present which imply consent, as
  23 described in section 431.063.
- 24 3. A health care provider shall notify a patient of
   25 any patient examination performed under subsection 2 of this
   26 section.
- 27 <u>4. A health care provider who violates the provisions</u>
  28 <u>of this section, or who supervises a student or trainee who</u>
  29 <u>violates the provisions of this section, shall be subject to</u>
  30 <u>discipline by any licensing board that licenses the health</u>
  31 care provider.
