10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Pawnbroker to ensure firearm not stolen. Before a pawnbroker or junk
13	dealer accepts a firearm as part of a pawn transaction or purchases a firearm, the pawnbroker or junk dealer
14	shall:
15	(1) notify a peace officer employed by the city, town, or county where the pawnshop or junk shop is
16	located of the receipt of the firearm and provide all pertinent information related to the firearm, including:
17	(a) the date the firearm was brought to the pawnshop or junk shop;
18	(b) the serial number of the firearm; and
19	(c) a description of the firearm.
20	(2) The peace officer or a law enforcement agency shall conduct a search of the national crime
21	information center database to determine whether the firearm is stolen. The search must be completed in 10
22	minutes.
23	(3) If the peace officer or law enforcement agency determines that the firearm is stolen, the procedures
24	found in 46-5-212 must be followed.
25	(4) A pawnshop or junk shop shall post a large, clearly readable sign that is visible as patrons enter the
26	pawnshop or junk shop advising patrons that all firearms to be pawned or to be purchased by the pawnbroker
27	or junk dealer will be checked by the peace officer or law enforcement agency using the national crime
28	information center database to determine whether the firearms are stolen.
