- 2 28-1212.04, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to change
- 3 provisions relating to discharge of a firearm; and to repeal the

- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-1212.04, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2014, is amended to read:

3 28-1212.04 Any person, ~~within the territorial boundaries of any city~~
4 ~~of the first class or county containing a city of the metropolitan class~~
5 ~~or primary class,~~ who unlawfully, knowingly, and intentionally or
6 recklessly discharges a firearm, while in any motor vehicle or in the
7 proximity of any motor vehicle that such person has just exited, at or in
8 the general direction of any person, dwelling, building, structure,
9 occupied motor vehicle, occupied aircraft, inhabited motor home as
10 defined in section 71-4603, or inhabited camper unit as defined in
11 section 60-1801, is guilty of a Class IC felony.
