AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIME; CREATING THE CRIME OF UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A RATE OF FIRE ACCELERATOR; PROVIDING A PENALTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 30, Article 7 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A RATE OF FIRE ACCELERATOR.--

- A. Unlawful possession of a rate of fire accelerator consists of a person knowingly possessing a firearm accessory or any other device, part or combination of parts that is designed or functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semiautomatic firearm.
- B. A person who commits unlawful possession of a rate of fire accelerator is guilty of a fourth degree felony.

1	C. For the purpose of this section:				
2	(1) "semiautomatic firearm" means a firearm				
3	that:				
4	(a) uses a portion of the energy of a				
5	firing cartridge to extract a fired cartridge case and to				
6	chamber the next round; and				
7	(b) requires a separate pull of the				
8	trigger to fire each cartridge; and				
9	(2) "person" does not include the state or a				
10	subdivision of the state."
