- (3) a student, instructor or other schoolauthorized personnel engaged in army, navy, marine corps or air force reserve officer training corps programs or stateauthorized hunter safety training instruction;
- (4) a person conducting or participating in a school-approved program, class or other activity involving the carrying of a deadly weapon; [or]
- (5) a person older than nineteen years of age on school premises in a private automobile or other private means of conveyance, for lawful protection of the person's or another's person or property; or
- (6) a contract school security guard registered as a level three security guard and supervised pursuant to the Private Investigations Act.
 - B. As used in this section:
 - (1) "school premises" means:

[(1)] (a) the buildings and grounds, including playgrounds, playing fields and parking areas and any school bus of any public elementary, secondary, junior high or high school in or on which school or school-related activities are being operated under the supervision of a local school board; or
