4 **SECTION 12.(a)** G.S. 130A-131.7 reads as rewritten:

5 **"§ 130A-131.7. Definitions.**

6 The following definitions apply in this Part:

8 (4) "Department" means the Department of ~~Environmental Quality Health and~~
9 Human Services or its authorized agent.

11 (7) "Lead poisoning hazard" means any of the following:

13 c. Any concentration of lead dust that is equal to or greater than ~~40-10~~
14 micrograms per square foot on floors ~~or 250, 100~~ micrograms per
15 square foot on interior windowsills, or 250 micrograms per square foot
16 on vinyl miniblinds, bathtubs, kitchen sinks, or lavatories.

19 **SECTION 12.(b)** G.S. 130A-131.9C(i), as amended by S.L. 2021-69, reads as
20 rewritten:

21 "(i) All remediation plans shall require that the lead poisoning hazards be reduced to the
22 following levels:

- 23 (1) ~~Fewer~~ Less than 40-10 micrograms per square foot for lead dust on floors.
24 (2) ~~Fewer~~ Less than 250-100 micrograms per square foot for lead dust on interior
25 ~~windowsills, bathtubs, kitchen sinks, and lavatories.~~ windowsills.
26 (2a) Less than 250 micrograms per square foot for lead dust on vinyl miniblinds,
27 bathtubs, kitchen sinks, and lavatories.
28 (3) ~~Fewer~~ Less than 400 micrograms per square foot for lead dust on window
29 troughs.
30 (4) ~~Fewer~~ Less than 400 parts per million for lead in bare soil in play areas,
31 gardens, pet sleeping areas, and areas within three feet of the residential



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1 housing unit or child-occupied facility. Lead in bare soil in other locations of
2 the yard shall be reduced to less than 1,200 parts per million.
3 (5) ~~Fewer~~ Less than 10 parts per billion for lead in drinking water."
4 **SECTION 12.(c)** This section becomes effective on December 1, 2021.
