## **ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2039**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10, a new section to chapter
- 2 15.1-27, and a new section to chapter 15.1-36 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a
- 3 scholarship fund, uses of the foundation aid stabilization fund, and a school construction
- 4 assistance loan fund; to provide a continuing appropriation; to provide for transfers; and to
- 5 provide for a contingent effective date.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 8 and enacted as follows:
- 9 Scholarship fund.
- The scholarship fund is a special fund in the state treasury. Moneys deposited in the fund
- 11 <u>must remain in the fund on a permanent basis. Any interest or other earnings of the fund must</u>
- be used to award scholarships to residents of this state attending institutions of higher
- 13 <u>education in the state. The state board of higher education shall develop rules and guidelines</u>
- 14 for the award of scholarships from interest or other earnings of the fund.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 16 and enacted as follows:
- 17 Uses of the foundation aid stabilization fund.
- Any funds that remain in the foundation aid stabilization fund, after transfers to other funds,
- 19 <u>must be used to provide state aid to school districts and educationally related property tax relief</u>
- 20 to school district patrons.
- 21 **SECTION 3.** A new section to chapter 15.1-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 22 and enacted as follows:

1	School construction assistance loan fund - Continuing appropriation.
2	The school construction assistance loan fund is a special revolving loan fund in the state
3	treasury. Moneys in the fund are appropriated on a continuing basis for the purpose of providing
4	low-interest school construction loans. Any interest or other earnings of the fund must be
5	deposited in the fund.
6	SECTION 4. TRANSFER - FOUNDATION AID STABILIZATION FUND TO SCHOOL
7	CONSTRUCTION ASSISTANCE LOAN FUND. During the period beginning July 1, 2016, and
8	ending June 30, 2017, the office of management and budget shall transfer an amount equal to
9	the lesser of \$300,000,000 or fifty percent of the balance of the foundation aid stabilization fund
10	on July 1, 2016, from the foundation aid stabilization fund to the school construction assistance
11	loan fund.
12	SECTION 5. TRANSFER - FOUNDATION AID STABILIZATION FUND TO
13	SCHOLARSHIP FUND. During the period beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017,
14	the office of management and budget shall transfer an amount equal to the lesser of
15	\$300,000,000 or fifty percent of the balance of the foundation aid stabilization fund on July 1,
16	2016, from the foundation aid stabilization fund to the scholarship fund.
17	SECTION 6. CONTINGENT EFFECTIVE DATE. Sections 2, 4, and 5 of this Act are
18	contingent on the passage of Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 4003 by the sixty-fourth
19	legislative assembly and approval of that resolution by the voters of this state. If sections 2, 4,
20	and 5 of this Act take effect, the sections become effective on July 1, 2016.
