3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 44-04-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 44-04-09. Nepotism Exceptions.
- 7 A state official or state employee, in the exercise of that official's or employee's duties, 8 may not serve in a supervisory capacity over, or enter a personal service contract with, 9 that official's or employee's parent by birth or adoption, spouse, son or daughter by 10 birth or adoption, stepchild, brother or sister by whole or half blood or by adoption, 11 brother-in-law or sister-in-law, or son-in-law or daughter-in-law. As used in this section, 12 "supervisory capacity" means the authority to appoint, employ, hire, assign, transfer, 13 promote, evaluate, reward, discipline, demote, or terminate. As used in this section, 14 "evaluate" does not include evaluations by peers or subordinates.
- 15 <u>2.</u> This section does not apply to an:
- 16 <u>a.</u> An employment relationship or contract entered before August 1, 1999; nor to 17 <u>any</u>
 - <u>An</u> employment relationship or contract entered before the state official or employee assumed the supervisory capacity; nor to any
 - <u>c.</u> Any temporary work arrangement necessary to meet a critical and urgent agency need: <u>or</u>
 - d. An employment relationship or contract entered to meet a critical and urgent employment need which is entered with the prior approval of a committee or other governing body that has general supervision over a state entity.
