6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to courts; amending Section 1,  
8 Chapter 267, O.S.L. 2013, as amended by Section 2,  
9 Chapter 368, O.S.L. 2014 (20 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section  
10 129), which relates to judicial firearms permits;  
authorizing federal judges to carry firearms under  
11 certain circumstances; and providing an effective  
12 date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 267, O.S.L.  
15 2013, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 368, O.S.L. 2014 (20 O.S.  
16 Supp. 2014, Section 129), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 129. A judge of the United States district court, judge  
18 of the district court, municipal judge, or retired judge of the  
19 district court who receives a statement from the appropriate  
20 retirement system verifying the status of the person as a retired  
21 judge of the district court may carry a firearm on his or her person  
22 anywhere in the state to use only for personal protection if the  
23 person has successfully completed a handgun qualification course for  
24 court officials developed by the Council on Law Enforcement

1 Education and Training. The Council on Law Enforcement Education  
2 and Training may provide for an identification card to be issued to  
3 the judge of the United States district court, judge of the district  
4 court, retired judge of the district court, or municipal judge and  
5 may provide application forms. If the person issued an  
6 identification card is no longer eligible, that person shall  
7 immediately return the identification card to the Council on Law  
8 Enforcement Education and Training.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
