6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Bus Passenger Safety Act,
8 amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1902, which relates to
9 definitions regarding public bus transportation;
10 modifying definitions; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section
11 1903, which relates to unlawful acts; removing
12 certain prohibitions; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section
13 1904, which relates to unauthorized removal on public
14 bus transportation; clarifying language; and
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1902, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1902. As used in ~~this act~~ the Bus Passenger Safety Act:

20 1. "Bus" ~~shall be defined as provided in Section 1-105 of Title~~
21 47 means a vehicle designed to carry passengers that is part of a
22 network of passenger vehicles for use by the public, running on a
23 regular schedule of routes, times and fares;

24 2. "Bus transportation company" or "company" means any person
or governmental entity providing for-hire transport to passengers ~~or~~

1 ~~charge~~ by bus upon the roads, streets, highways and turnpikes of this
2 state, ~~whether in interstate or intrastate travel;~~

3 3. "Deadly or dangerous weapon" ~~includes~~ means all weapons
4 listed in ~~Sections~~ Section 1287 and ~~1289.3 through 1289.5~~ of this
5 title, and any other weapon capable of inflicting serious bodily
6 injury; except for a weapon carried for lawful self-defense in
7 compliance under the Oklahoma Self Defense Act for lawful self-
8 defense;

9 4. "Passenger" means any person served by the bus
10 transportation company ~~and in addition to the ordinary meaning of~~
11 ~~passenger, the term shall include persons accompanying or meeting~~
12 ~~another who is transported by this company, any person shipping or~~
13 ~~receiving cargo and any person purchasing a ticket or receiving a~~
14 ~~pass; and~~

15 5. "Terminal" means a bus station or depot or any facility
16 operated or leased by or operated on behalf of a bus transportation
17 company. This term shall include a reasonable area immediately
18 adjacent to any designated stop along the route traveled by any
19 ~~coach~~ bus operated by a bus transportation company and parking lots
20 or parking areas adjacent to a terminal.

21 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1903, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 1903. A. No person shall by force or violence, or
24 threat of force or violence, seize or exercise control of any bus.

1 Any person violating this subsection shall be guilty of a felony⁷
2 and shall, upon conviction, be ~~imprisoned~~ punished by imprisonment
3 in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not more than
4 twenty (20) years, or ~~fined~~ by a fine of not more than Twenty
5 Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and
6 imprisonment.

7 B. In addition, no person shall intimidate, threaten, assault
8 or batter any driver, attendant, guard or passenger of any bus with
9 intent to violate subsection A of this section. Any person
10 violating this subsection shall be guilty of a felony⁷ and shall,
11 upon conviction, be ~~imprisoned~~ punished by imprisonment in the
12 custody of the Department of Corrections for not more than ten (10)
13 years, or ~~fined~~ by a fine of not more than Five Thousand Dollars
14 (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

15 C. In addition, any person violating subsection A or B of this
16 section using a dangerous or deadly weapon shall be guilty of a
17 felony, and shall, upon conviction, be ~~imprisoned~~ punished by
18 imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not
19 more than twenty (20) years, or ~~fined~~ by a fine of not more than
20 Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and
21 imprisonment.

22 ~~D. No person, other than an authorized law enforcement officer,~~
23 ~~shall board a bus with a dangerous or deadly weapon concealed upon~~
24 ~~or about his person. Upon the discovery of any such item or~~

1 ~~material, the company may obtain possession and retain custody of~~
2 ~~such item or material until it is transferred to the custody of law~~
3 ~~enforcement officers. Any person convicted of violating this~~
4 ~~subsection shall be guilty of a felony, and shall, upon conviction,~~
5 ~~be imprisoned for not more than ten (10) years, or fined not more~~
6 ~~than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or both.~~

7 E. ~~It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm~~
8 ~~or hurl or place in the path any missile at, into or within any bus,~~
9 ~~terminal or other transportation facility. Such person shall, upon~~
10 ~~conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of not more~~
11 ~~than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or by imprisonment for not~~
12 ~~more than five (5) years, or both.~~

13 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1904, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1904. It shall be unlawful to remove any baggage, cargo
16 or other item transported upon a bus or stored in a terminal without
17 consent of the owner of such property or the company, or its duly
18 authorized representative. Any person violating this section shall
19 be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a
20 fine of not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or
21 imprisoned by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of
22 Corrections for not more than five (5) years, or by both such fine
23 and imprisonment.
